

**Castel San Valentino - Pinot Grigio - 1995***Italy*

Fresh and Crisp. Fruit consists of citrus dominated by grapefruit & honeydew. Finish, smooth with light spice and juniper berries.
 FOOD: Enjoy with brunch foods, appetizers or alone. Worth having a few bottles in the fridge! Great deck wine!

Alderbrook - Sauvignon Blanc - 1995*Napa*

Citrus/floral bouquet. Good body with lots of citrus & nice butter flavors. Finish is lemon-lime with a touch of spice.

Laurel Glenn - Reds - 1995*Napa (Red blend)*

Light body. Nice & well balanced with mild fruit. A good basic table wine for everyday.

Eberle - Zinfandel - 1995*Paso Robles*

Flavor is abundant from sip to swallow. Although no eventful flavor explosion, the apples, berries & cherries are prominent throughout. The wine finishes long with oak and fruit skins

Elio Altare Viticoltore - Barbera - 1994*Alba, Italy*

Medium body red wine. Initial palette is reminiscent of Beaujolais Nouveau, followed by light berries & mellow jam. Wine finishes with tart pomegranates and oak. Very good. Worth the experience.

Taurino Patriglione - Brindisi - 1990*Italy*

Different & Interesting! Full body with lots of complex fruit dominated by deliciously rich black cherries. The finish is reminiscent of Port, Brandy, Oak and a touch of chocolate! Outstanding!
 FOOD: Went extremely well with chicken in a rich sherry & red pepper sauce. (also any red meat or pasta)

Alderbrook - Merlot- 1994*Kunde Vineyard*

Delicious medium to full body. Awesome black cherries explode with flavor before finishing with some mild spice, some wood and bitter-sweet chocolate - delightful finish!

Verichon Et Clerc - Champagne - 1995*France*

Mondavi - Cabernet Sauvignon - 1993*Napa - Unfiltered*

Nice fruit, especially cherries. A bit young yet & therefore tight, however the tannin/oak finish was tolerable. Well balanced. Should be quite delicious in a few years.
